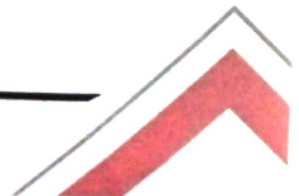

PARLIAMENT DRAMA | Both Houses adjourn sine die after a session that saw constant protests and little debate

Stormy Monsoon Session ends amid disruptions

NEW DELHI

Both Houses of Parliament were adjourned sine die on Thursday, bringing to a close a Monsoon Session that was marked by repeated disruptions and limited legislative debate.

The session saw no Question Hour, while several Bills were passed amid Opposition protests over the theft of donations to the Ram Temple, NEET paper leak and demands for a statement from Home Minister Amit Shah on police action against students protesting over the issue.

Parliamentary Affairs Minister Kiren Rijiju described the session as "very successful" in

terms of legislative business, saying 12 Bills had been passed. The minister, however, acknowledged that only one of these Bills – the Public Examinations (Prevention of Unfair Means) Act – was discussed properly. He also admitted that the performance in terms of debate and discussion had been less satisfactory.

Rijiju added that while Opposition parties had frequently protested and staged walkouts, NDA MPs and members of some Opposition parties had participated in debates.

The Lok Sabha was adjourned sine die shortly after the national song, Vande Mataram, was played at the start of the final sitting. Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Home Minister Amit Shah were present in the House.

This incidentally was the first appearance of Shah in the House during the Session even as the Opposition kept protesting that he reveal to the House who ordered the police action on protesting students in Delhi last month.

Congress general secretary

and MP Priyanka Gandhi Vadra made a mention of this aspect when she told the media that the leaders had appeared on the final day "just to sing Vande Mataram". Vadra also criticised the government saying, "Neither the Prime Minister nor the Home Minister came to the House. How will democracy and Parliament function?"

She added that the leaders had appeared on the final day "just to sing Vande Mataram", after the session had already concluded.

Leader of the Opposition in the Rajya Sabha Mallikarjun Kharge also accused the PM and HM of avoiding the House and urged them to attend the proceedings.

CONG LISTS FIVE WINS OF OPPOSITION

The Congress on Thursday said that its not letting the Centre get four of its contentious Bills passed was among the "five major achievements" of the Opposition during the Monsoon Session of Parliament.

Addressing a press conference on the conclusion of the session, Congress MP and general secretary Jairam Ramesh said, four of the Opposition's achievements pertained to not letting the "One Nation, One Election Bill; Viksit Bharat Shiksha Adhishthan Bill; Constitution (130th Amendment) Bill; and the 'FCRA Bill' get passed in Parliament.

Elaborating on these, Ramesh said the government intended to introduce the One Nation, One Election bill during the but it was deferred until the winter session. "The second major success concerns the Viksit Bharat Shiksha Adhishthan (VBSA) Bill that seeks the massive centralization of all universities...the report was deferred until the winter session," he said.

The third bill was the Constitution (One Hundred and Thir-

teenth Amendment) Bill, which proposed the automatic dismissal of ministers, Chief Ministers, and Prime Ministers. Here too, Ramesh said while "the report was being finalized, and a clause-by-clause discussion was underway, it was announced mid-meeting that the report would not be presented in this session."

Finally, he said, while "for the past 10 days, there was a massive media buzz suggesting the FCRA Bill was just around the corner and the Home Minister remained absolutely adamant that it would be introduced, then came a call from the US Vice President, and we saw the result."

Ramesh said "there was pressure from us and from various organizations, but the US Vice President's intervention was certainly a factor," in getting the proposed legislation stalled.

The Congress leader insisted that "there is a fifth achievement as well". He said, "The BJP made a lot of efforts to secure a two-thirds majority, even breaking parties, but they could not succeed in this, and the Delimitation Bill could not be passed."

Over 14K sign petition seeking Birla's intervention against Priyanka's 'gau mutra' remark

A petition signed by more than 14,000 people, claiming to be members of the academic and scientific community, has sought Lok Sabha Speaker Om Birla's intervention over Congress MP Priyanka Gandhi Vadra's reference to IIT Madras Director V Kamakoti as a "gau mutra (urine) expert" during parliamentary proceedings.

The petition, launched on Change.org on August 1, seeks withdrawal of the "derogatory expression" and expresses regret for the remark's "personal and derogatory nature". A press note issued by the petitioners, calling themselves the 'Academic and Scientific Community', claimed that it has received support from people across India's disciplines, institutions and states, as well as overseas Indian scientists in over 38 countries. However, there was no mention of the petitioners' designations who signed it.

Syama Prasad Mookerjee's contributions to be included in Bengal's curriculum from 2027: Suwendu

West Bengal Chief Minister Suwendu Adhikari on Thursday said the contributions of Bharatiya Jana Sangh founder Syama Prasad Mookerjee will be included in the state's curriculum from school to university levels from the next academic year.

The decision was taken at the first meeting of a special committee constituted to plan and implement programmes marking Mookerjee's 125th birth anniversary.

"The School Education Department will include Syama Prasad Mookerjee's contribution

to the country, his far-reaching and development-oriented vision in independent India, and his constructive works in the syllabus from school to university levels," Adhikari said.

This is how the next generation will be made aware of Syama Prasad Mookerjee, the

chief minister said, adding that it has been decided that this will be implemented from the next academic year.

The state government will also publish a book on Mookerjee, as part of the programmes planned to mark his 125th birth anniversary, the CM said.

"An organisation with which Syama Prasad Mookerjee was once associated has already prepared a book through the efforts of (BJP leader) Tathagata Roy. We want to publish the book jointly with them. They will now convey their views on the matter," Adhikari said.

Fresh clash erupts along Assam-Arunachal border

Police fire in air to disperse mob

NORTH LAKHIMPUR (ASSAM)

A fresh clash erupted between protesters from Assam and Arunachal Pradesh in Dhemaji district on Thursday, forcing the police from the neighbouring state to fire in the air to control the mob even as the indefinite economic blockade against the Himalayan state entered its second day.

The Takam Mising Porin Kebang (TMPK), the apex student organisation of Assam's Mising community, and other local groups on Wednesday launched an indefinite economic blockade against Arun-

achal Pradesh in protest against the alleged firing in which 12 indigenous people from Assam were injured.

"When the blockade was going on, some people from Arunachal Pradesh indulged in stone pelting on protesters from Assam and some persons sustained minor injuries. This led to a scuffle between the two sides," an official said.

The incident took place at Likabali entry point in Silapathar in Dhemaji district of Assam, he added.

"Then we saw that police from Arunachal fired three rounds in the air to control the mob on their side," the Assam government official said.

Nine Indian fishermen arrested by SL Navy; TN CM urges Jaishankar to intervene

Tamil Nadu Chief Minister C. Joseph Vijay wrote to External Affairs Minister S Jaishankar on Thursday, seeking the Centre's urgent diplomatic intervention in the arrest of nine Indian fishermen from Tamil Nadu and the seizure of their mechanised boat by the Sri Lankan Navy while they were purportedly fishing off Katchatheevu.

Highlighting the recurring detentions, CM Vijay requested Jaishankar to take up the matter with the Sri Lankan government to secure the

early release of the fishers and their vessel.

According to an official release, the fishermen hailing from Ramanathapuram district were apprehended in the late hours of August 12. This marks the second such incident reported in August alone. As on date, 49 Indian fishermen continue to remain in Sri Lankan custody.

The repeated arrests are causing "anxiety and a deep sense of insecurity among the fishing community, particularly in the coastal districts of Tamil Nadu," the chief minister noted in his letter.

Sixty-four-year-old Badal, the former deputy chief minister of Punjab, was attacked by a man with a kirpan (ceremonial dagger worn by Sikhs) while visiting the Gurdwara Mata Sahib Devan Ji Mugat, according to the Maharashtra Police. Nanded SP Neelabh Rohan told PTI, "A nihang (member of a martial order of Sikhs) attacked Badal with a kirpan inside the gurdwara. The assailant has been taken into custody." The assailant has been taken into custody, the IPS officer said.

A local official in Nanded said Badal is out of danger. He was taken to a hospital where he received two to three stitches on his right hand, the official said.

खुल सकेंगे, लेकिन कर्मचारियों के काम के घंटे नियमों के दायरे में रहेंगे।
ऑनलाइन रजिस्ट्रेशन से आसान होगी प्रक्रिया-नई सहिता के तहत दुकानों और व्यावसायिक प्रतिष्ठानों के लिए अब एक बार ऑनलाइन रजिस्ट्रेशन पर्याप्त होगा। इससे बार-बार पंजीयन कराने की प्रक्रिया से राहत मिलने की उम्मीद है। वहीं सुरक्षा, साफ-सफाई, फायर सेफ्टी और आपातकालीन व्यवस्था की जिम्मेदारी प्रतिष्ठान संचालक की होगी। महिलाओं की सुरक्षा पर विशेष प्रावधान-नई व्यवस्था में महिला कर्मचारियों के लिए सुरक्षित कार्यस्थल सुनिश्चित करने के विशेष प्रावधान किए गए हैं। नियमों का उल्लंघन होने पर श्रम विभाग प्रतिष्ठानों की जांच कर सकेगा और नियमानुसार कार्रवाई करेगा। यानी कारोबार के समय में छूट के साथ कर्मचारियों के अधिकार और सुरक्षा की जिम्मेदारी भी तय की गई है।
